

TAAD-5™ Triage Assessment for Addictive Disorders-5

The TAAD-5 is a brief, structured interview designed to identify current alcohol and other drug problems. This 10-minute assessment tool covers all *DSM-5* criteria for substance use disorders. It offers high internal reliability. The TAAD-5 produces alcohol and drug use disorder profiles similar to those of more time intensive instruments.

A technician or paraprofessional can administer the TAAD-5 for interpretation by a qualified professional. A scoring summary is incorporated into each instrument and can be completed in 2-3 minutes.

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Applications:

- Any situation requiring fast, initial discrimination between a likely substance use disorder or no diagnosis.
- Ideal for preliminary triage to determine if a treatment referral or intake assessment is indicated.
- Other settings for use include:
 - a quick initial assessment of DUI/DWI offenders
 - initial EAP assessments, mental health clinics, primary care settings or emergency rooms.
 - initial field assessments by child protection, welfare workers or other social service providers.

- Offers a quick assessment of current substance use disorder criteria.
- Provides support for substance use disorder diagnoses in minutes.
- Documents negative findings for those individuals who do not see problems.




SUDDS-5[™] Substance Use Disorder Diagnostic Schedule-5

The SUDDS-5 is a comprehensive interview that provides documentation of substance-specific diagnoses based on the DSM-5.

This 35- to 45-minute interview covers both current and lifetime indications of substance use disorders. It also screens for current and past indications of depression and anxiety disorders.

Internal consistency reliability coefficients for individual substances range from .90 to .98.

This instrument provides information compatible with ASAM's criteria for treatment planning and placement. Scoring can be completed within five minutes.




Applications:

- ◆ Intake diagnostic tool for substance-related disorders.
- ◆ Ideal for use in case management, such as oversight following positive drug tests for safety-sensitive workers.
- ◆ Helpful in situations where litigation or challenges to findings might be involved.
- ◆ Excellent for developing court testimony or any situation where detailed objective documentation is required.

- ◆ Can be completed in a single session or in segments over multiple sessions without losing the context of previous responses.

- Respondent sign-off provides an option to have individuals attest to the accuracy of the information provided.




CAAPE-5[™] Comprehensive Addictions and Psychological Evaluation-5

The CAAPE-5 is a comprehensive diagnostic assessment interview providing documentation for substance-specific diagnoses based on *DSM-5* criteria. In 20-35 minutes, the CAAPE-5 covers some of the more prevalent mental health conditions likely to impact recovery from substance use disorders and collects key demographic information associated with prognosis.

CONDITIONS COVERED:

- Substance specific use disorders
- Major depressive episode
- Manic episode
- Panic disorder
- Anxiety and phobia indications
- Post traumatic stress disorder
- Obsessive-compulsive disorder
- Psychosis
- Antisocial personality disorder

- Borderline personality disorder
- Dependent personality disorder
- Obsessive-compulsive personality disorder



Applications:

- Intake diagnostic tool for mental health and substance use disorders.
- Aids in motivational enhancement by offering detailed behaviors and symptoms of conditions.
- Documentable to help determine if the conditions have improved or if recovery can be recorded.
- ◆ Interview can be taken all at once or broken up into separate sessions without losing context.




PADDI-5[™] Practical Adolescent Dual Diagnostic Interview-5

The PADDI-5 is a comprehensive interview based on the *DSM-5* for identifying co-occurring mental health and substance use disorders among adolescents. This interview enables both addiction and mental health professionals to document problems within their areas of expertise and make focused referrals for conditions outside their scope of practice.

The PADDI-5 covers the following areas in accordance with the *DSM-5*:

- Substance use disorders
- Major depressive episodes
- Manic episodes
- Panic attacks
- PTSD
- ADHD
- Conduct disorder
- Oppositional defiant disorder
- Also covered in the context of this 35-45 minute interview are:
 - Dangerousness to self or others
 - Victimization: physical, sexual and emotional abuse
 - Symptoms indicative of psychosis
 - Indications of phobias and generalized anxiety



All this information can be collected and summarized in this efficient and client-friendly interview designed by experts in assessment and clinical practice. The flow of the interview can actually contribute to the development of rapport with the adolescent.

Applications:

- Initial evaluation of co-occurring mental health and substance use disorders in adolescents.
- Excellent for use in juvenile justice, mental health and addiction treatment settings and court diversion.
- Can be used in clinics, treatment centers and private practices.
- Can be repeated to determine adolescent's progress.
- Used for monitoring affective and anxiety disorders.

- Fully compatible with DSM-5; but can also address DSM-IV.
- Appropriate for both private practice and public settings: Administration (35-50 minutes) and scoring (less than five minutes) can be completed during a typical outpatient interview or intake.
- Convenient means of documenting and reporting findings.
- Administration does not require special training for licensed clinicians.
- ◆ Technicians and paraprofessionals can administer the interview with minimal training.
- Findings from the PADDI-5 can inform Dimensions 1,
 3, 5 and 6 of ASAM's criteria.
